MMC Hardmetal UK BREXIT Preparations: Update September 2020

With the date of exit of the United Kingdom from the EU approaching MMC Hardmetal UK continue to prepare for all eventualities that may impact on the supply and delivery of items.

To satisfy requests we are receiving from various customers the following statement explains what stage our preparations are at, along with the schedule we will work on between now and 31st December 2020.

The most important advice that we can offer all customers that will ensure there is minimum risk of disruption to supply is to consult with MMC on scheduled orders. This ensures MMC can prepare and allocate stock to your account that will ensure delivery and availability is met irrespective of any delays that will occur during the transition period. MMC can arrange delivery into UK in sufficient time that will then allow us to forward these items to customers on the requested dates.

To prepare for the changes to goods arriving into the UK from EU we are in consultation with our logistics warehouse and carriers and in relation to the following points we expect to be in a position to confirm these are in place prior to 31st December 2020.

This is dependent on UK government releasing the necessary information in sufficient time for us to put these plans into action. The points currently being planned are as follows:

- Shipment delivery timescale impact of goods requiring customs clearance
- Customs declarations
- Applying EORI Numbering if required
- Confirmation of Country of Origin of product if required
- Preparing stock in relation to scheduled orders from customers

These points will be updated and confirmed once all relevant information has been released by UK & EU authorities.
